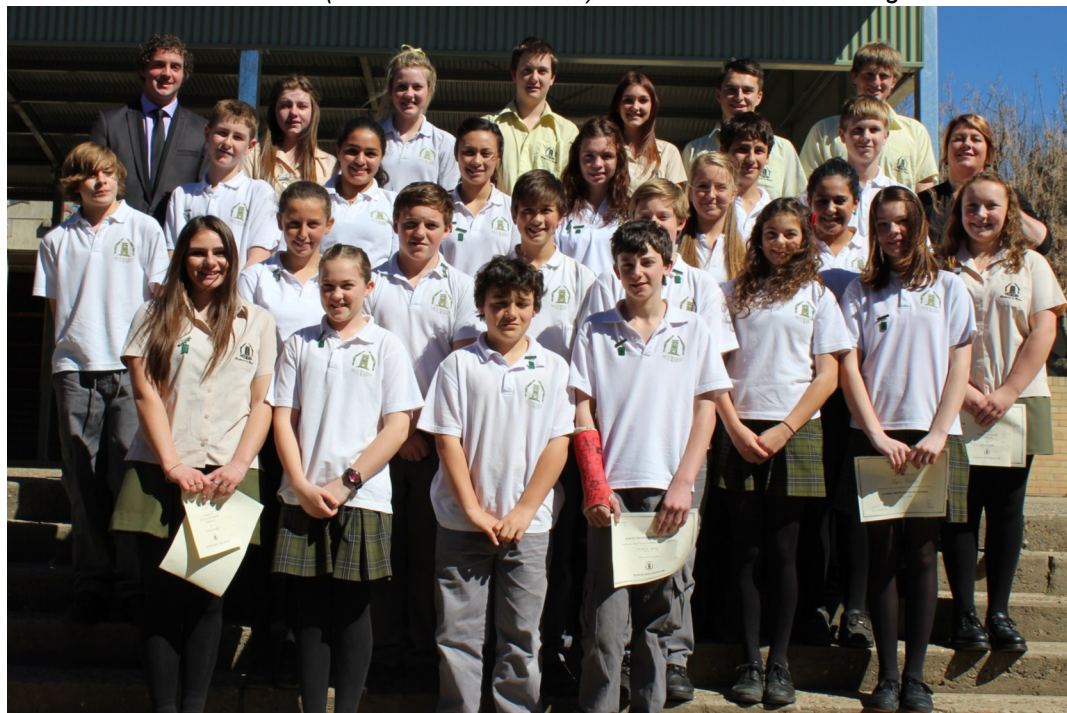

The film shows one of the main characters performing the feat for the first time in history.

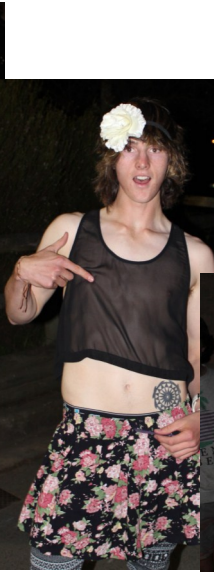
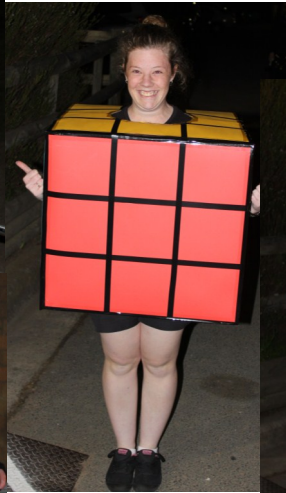


### HSC - Hot, Sweaty Carnivale
