REMEMBRANCE MUSEUM REVERIE

From the Friends of Mulwaree Museum (FOMM), an update on what is happening in relation to your Remembrance Museum.

We are still waiting (patiently?) for the installation of a storage container which was donated by the Kenmore Hospital Museum Committee in August last year. Once finally installed, it will allow some of the memorabilia to "be rested" and provide more room to change over exhibition items. It is anticipated that Art classes might be interested in creating a military mural to cover the container.

Recent donations to the Museum include a wicker clothes storage basket from the Goulburn Soap World. This will hold uniforms that are suitable for "dress-ups", which are always popular with young visitors. For convenience, the basket has had added to it, a wheel base – construction time and materials donated by Mr. L.M. Godkin. Other donations (anonymously) include a vacuum cleaner and a dress makers 'dummy'. Thanks to those generous donors. Unfortunately, the Museum missed out on a Museums and Galleries NSW grant. Feedback indicated it was due to the fact that the Museum is not open enough. FOMM hopes to improve the open hours, however, they will need your support to do this. 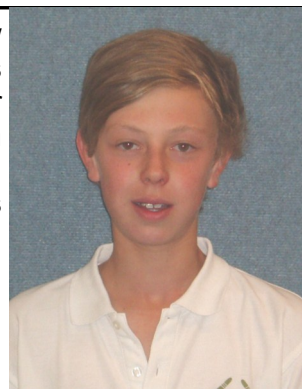
